



## MEDICAL COMPLIANCE HEALTHCARE RESOURCES

- If your family has a medical home or a regular healthcare provider, schedule a back to school appointment with them as soon as possible. A medical home will allow your child and family to access better healthcare.
- Most people who are found eligible for Medicaid must choose a Primary Care Provider (Medical Home). The Illinois Client Enrollment Broker will help you understand your healthcare choices, so that you can choose the best plan for you. - Some retail clinics like Target, Walgreens and CVS can provide services to a Medicaid population. There are also some Walgreens clinics that carry vaccines for an uninsured and Medicaid child population (18 years and younger).
- The Chicago Department of Public Health Fast Track Clinics provides immunizations at no charge for children 0-18 years of age.
